SPECIAL EVENT ENFORCEMENT

SBI agents can attend special events in your jurisdiction to prevent service to minors and over service.

SIP OPERATIONS

To prevent on-premise retailers from over serving patrons, SBI agents conduct "Serving Intoxicated Patrons" ops.

TRAINING

We can provide training to you and officers in your jurisdiction regarding alcohol laws and alcohol enforcement activities.

Targeted Response to Alcohol-Connected Emergencies

On-Premise and Off-Premise

YOU CAN REPORT DIRECTLY TO ABC

- DABC cannot take action without notification.
- Complete a report and fax it to:
DABC
fax: 801-977-6888
AET fax: 801-532-3769 (we track inspections)

WHEN TO REPORT

8 BUSINESS DAYS - after a violation, it must be reported to DABC within 8 business days or DABC can't take action

WHAT'S IN THE REPORT

PICTURES

Of CUBs, IDs & alcoholic product sold



STATEMENTS

from officers - how sale occurred, what they saw
from CUBs - what server said & did

COPY OF CITATION

COMMON VIOLATIONS

32B-4-403

Sale/supply of alcohol to minors

32B-1-407

Failure to verify age

- Issue citation at time of violation
- Complete administrative referral later

HOLDING SOURCES ACCOUNTABLE

The AET conducts TRACE investigations to identify the source of alcohol that may have contributed to a crash or other incident involving alcohol.

The TRACE investigation will not interfere with your agency's investigation of the incident.

CRITERIA

- Minor(s) involved
- Alcohol-related fatality or serious injury
- Alcohol served to intoxicated person
- Do not need all 3

WE CAN ASSIST WITH

- search warrant affidavits
- receipts
- interviews
- vehicle searches
- cell phone records
- surveillance video
- scanner records



REPORT TO DABC AND AET

4

Checks per year at each location

Send results to DABC and also the AET so we don't exceed 4 checks per year

UNDERAGE BUYER OPS INFO

- Train CUBs and assign numbers for their ID
- Carry their true ID
- They cannot lie about their age
- Collect statements from CUBs after sale
- Fax report of the sale to DABC & AET
- DABC 801-977-6888 AET 801-532-3769

EASY Program

Eliminating Alcohol Sales to Youth Compliance checks at grocery & convenience stores

Provides OT funds for your agency to conduct compliance checks at off-premise retailers. Do not use EASY for on-premise checks.

To conduct EASY checks, contact Utah Highway Safety Office 801-366-6040

- Report off-premise sales to your business licensing authority
- DABC does not license grocery/convenience stores
