

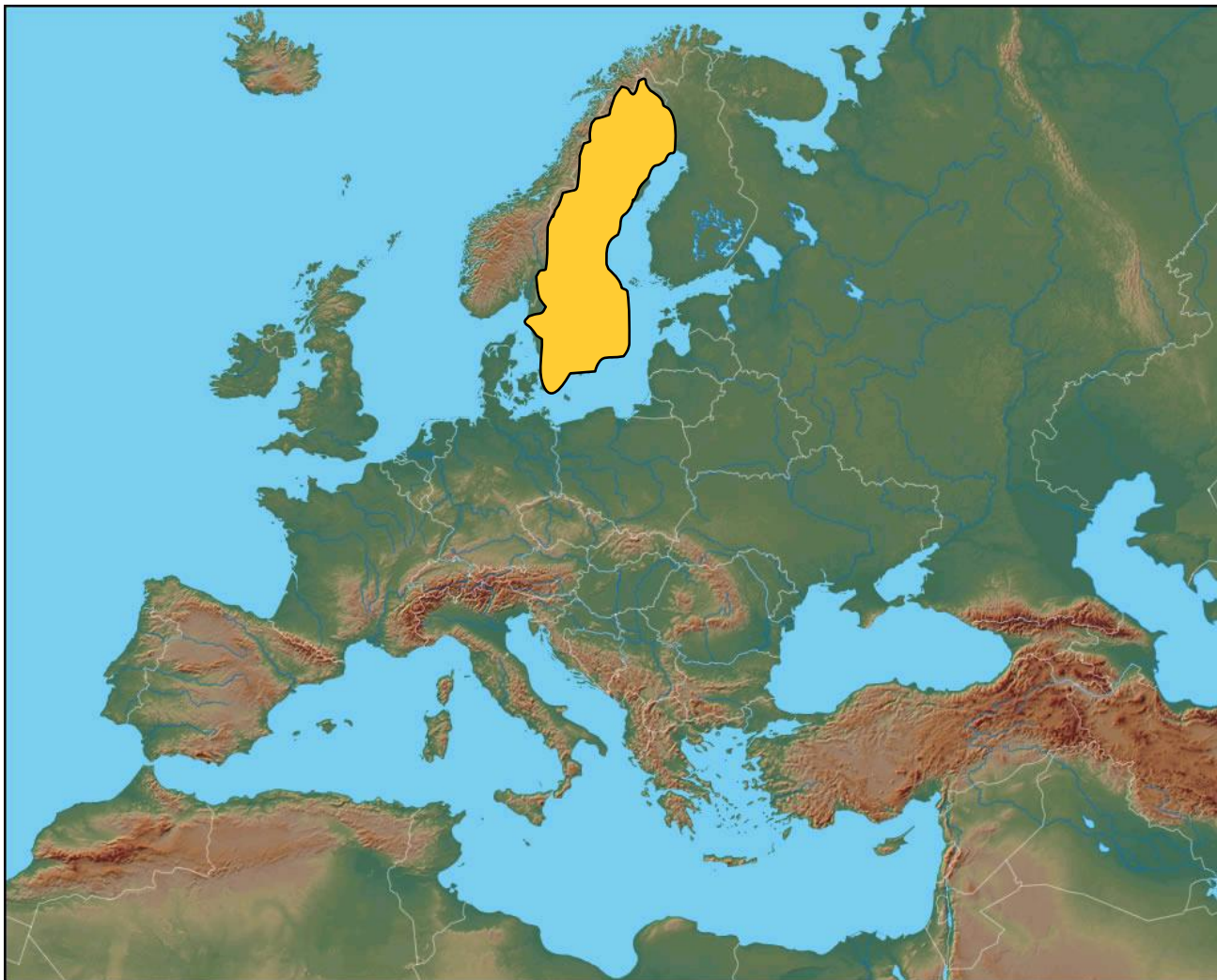

Stockholm County Police

The Swedish Alcohol Act

- 18 years to be served wine, beer and liquor
- 20 years to buy wine, beer and liquor
- No serving of alcohol to intoxicated guests
- Personal responsibility (up to 6 months in prison)
- State monopoly stores
- Premises need license, supervision by the police and the CAB
- Normal closing for bars etc is 1 am.
- Not later than 5 am.



Strategies

- No serving of alcohol to guests under the age of 18
- No serving of alcohol to intoxicated guests
- No selling of alcohol to customers under the age of 20 (18)
- No possessing of alcohol (<20 years)
- No illegal distribution of alcohol (minors)

- In co-operation



Serving in licensed premises

- STAD method (Co-operation, RBS-training, Enforcement)
- Student graduation parties
- National instructor training for policeofficers
- Evaluation by STAD

- 65 % denied (2011)

- 55% denied (1996)
- 92% denied (2007)
- Approx 90 % (2013)

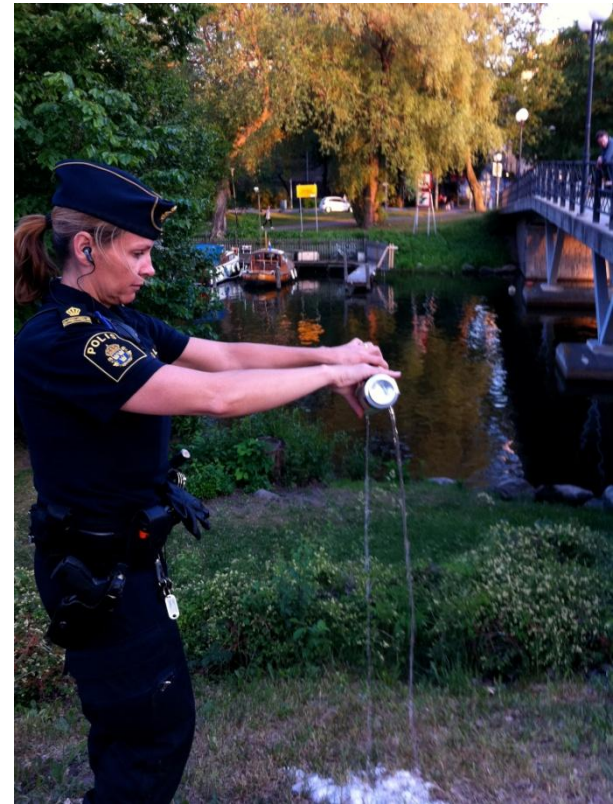
Stockholm County Police

Selling in monopoly stores (supermarkets)

- Education
- Co-operation
- Enforcement
- 95 % compliance rate checking ID (2013)

Possessing (minors)

- Confiscation
- Contact parents
- Trace the seller/distributor



Illegal distribution

- Ordering by text messages/phonecalls
- Delivery by car



At hot-spots



- High risk areas
- Lots of drunk people and overserved guests
- CCTV
- Mobile police stations
- In co-operation with licensed doormen and volunteers (desk)
- The nightphone
